



2024 Summer Sailing Program

The Pacific Corinthian Youth Foundation (PCYF) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable organization that sponsors and instructs youth sailing in Channel Islands Harbor. PCYF uses part of the grounds and the guest dock at Pacific Corinthian Yacht Club to host its Summer Sailing Program.

To participate in the PCYF Summer Sailing Program, each Student must:

- Be 8 - 18 years old during the current calendar year
- Demonstrate basic swimming skills
- Bring a non-inflating personal flotation device (PFD), water bottle, and lunch daily

Session	Dates

2	Jul 1* – Jul 12
3	Jul 15 – Jul 26
4	Jul 29 – Aug 9

*Session 2 Students will miss sailing camp on July 4th holiday. They may make up a day during another session by pre-arrangement with the Lead Instructor.

How to sign up:

2. Pay Enrollment Fees and include Student Name with payment:
 - **\$600** per Student for each 2-week session. No transaction fees if paid via Zelle, personal check or cash:

 - **\$620** per student for each 2-week session for Credit card/PayPal payment (includes \$20 transaction fee) to pcyfsailing@gmail.com
 - A limited number of scholarships may be available for Students who request financial assistance.

Instruction at 4 skill levels will be available during each of the 4 sessions:

Skill Level	Prerequisites
1 Beginner	8+ years old, able to swim, no prior sailing experience
2 Advanced Beginner	8+ years old, completion of Level 1 or equivalent
3 Intermediate	10+ years old, completion of Levels 1 & 2 or equivalent
4 Advanced	13+ years old, completion of Levels 1, 2, & 3 or equivalent

Fees must be paid to complete registration and reserve the Student’s session preference. In some cases, it may be necessary to assign the Student to an alternate Session. Students may enroll for multiple sessions - as space permits and if the Student has previously demonstrated good attendance and behavior.
